National Wildlife Quiz 2013: International Year of Water Co-operation WILD WISDOM

An initiative of WWF - India, supported by the Ministry of Environment and Forests (MoEF), Government of India and Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSC), New Delhi, the Wild Wisdom Quiz is a unique opportunity for students to delve deeper into India's amazing wildlife and gain knowledge and take pride in this natural legacy. This initiative aims to instill a sense of concern for the natural world and inspire our students to imbibe concern for conservation.

The Wild Wisdom Quiz is conducted in 17 cities in India and reaches out to more than 3000 schools in the country. National Finals will be held in New Delhi on the 4th of October, during the Wildlife Week.

The top 3 teams will win a once-in-a-lifetime trip in collaboration with Adventure Nation to their Snow Leopard Camp at Shivpuri (near Rishikesh), right after the Wild Wisdom National Finals. This prized experience will highlight 'Water' - the 2013 theme of the Wild Wisdom Quiz. To be conducted on the banks of the river Ganga, the camp activities will instill a sense of appreciation of the beauty and value for this river, which has shaped the history and culture of India. This time around too, teachers who mentor the 2 student Quiz Team and accompany them to the National Level Finals of Wild Wisdom will also receive the grand prize (the trip to the Snow Leopard Camp), a fitting reward for all their effort in preparing their students.

THEME: WATER

Water is essential for the existence, survival and propagation of all forms of life and covers approximately 70% of our earth's surface. To raise awareness about the challenges facing water management and the potential for increased cooperation in water sharing, the year 2013 has been declared by the United Nations as the **International Year of Water Cooperation**.

The Wild Wisdom Quiz highlights the need for water sharing both for people and for wildlife, with 70% of the quiz questions being related to habitats and ecosystems created by water in its various forms, and the flora and fauna contained therein – Himalaya high altitude wetlands and cold desert habitats, marine and freshwater ecosystems, coastal regions, marshlands and deltas of India. There will also be questions related to indigenous communities, terrain, ecology, and threats to wildlife in these areas. The remaining 30% will be generic and related to India.

• Who can participate?

Students of Classes 6, 7 and 8

• How can you participate?

Interested students need to register by paying a <u>one-time registration fee of Rs.100/-per participant</u>. The school registration form is attached as annexure - 02. For last date of, registrations refer to annexure - 01.

All students who register will receive a special gift package from WWF – India which includes:

- i. A DVD with 4 short films on the environment, from Chimi's World
- ii. A WWF badge
- iii. A participation certificate
- iv. The top 3 schools in each city, which exhibit the best all-round talent, by virtue of the highest number of registrations, will be awarded a special certificate by WWF India.

Level 2 (City Level): Participating schools from each city will come together at a venue in their respective cities; the details of which will be sent to them in time. For details on the venue, please log on to the website http://wwfindia.org/wildwisdom. The top 2 scorers from each school will represent their respective schools at the City Level. The City Level champions will win a place in the National Finals, to be held in Delhi on the 4th of October.

All participants will receive certificates and the top 3 schools will be awarded SPECIAL CERTIFICATES for making it to the final round. If a school is in a state where no city-level quiz is being held, they may choose the nearest city from the appended list and inform the person who is to conduct the quiz in that city.
