Dear Principal,

The Ministry of Power in association with Bureau of Energy Efficiency is undertaking the National Awareness Campaign 2015 involving children to enable them to inculcate the habit of energy conservation. This aims at sensitizing the children towards issues of energy conservation. One of the main activities of the campaign is a Painting Competition for school students.

The painting competition on energy conservation is being held since the year 2005 in three stages, namely, **School, State and National Level**. In 2014 around 60.00 lakh students from various parts of the country participated in the painting competition, which is an all-time record in the history of this painting competition. The winners of the national level painting competition were felicitated by the Hon'ble Union Minister of State for Power, Coal and New & Renewable Energy (Independent Charge) on 14th December, 2014 in a function held at Vigyan Bhawan, New Delhi.

Eligibility: Students of 4th, 5th & 6th standard students under **Category 'A'** and for 7th, 8th & 9th standard students under **Category 'B'** are eligible to participate in the competition.

School level Competition:

You are requested to organize a Painting Competition of 2 hours duration in your school for students of 4th, 5th & 6th standard students under **Category 'A'** and for 7th, 8th & 9th standard students under **Category 'B'** on any working day. **Students can use any size of paper but preferably A4 size and painting material such as pencil, colour pencils, crayons & water colours.**

Children can select any one of the following topics for the Painting Competition:

After the completion of painting competition, School Principal may select two best paintings along with information on the total no. of participants, percentage participation of students in both **Categories i.e 'A' & 'B'** (as applicable) and send them to the address of the Nodal Officer of their respective State/UT only **by 30th September, 2015**. The back page of the paintings should carry the following information:

All the participating students will be issued a certificate of participation by Bureau of Energy Efficiency, Ministry of Power, Govt. of India. The list of state wise Nodal officials and scheme is available at www.beeindia.in.

It is informed that all the participating students of School level painting competition will get a 'Certificate of participation' and 1st & 2nd selected will get 'Certificate of Merit' which will be signed by the respective school Principals and Director General, Bureau of Energy Efficiency, Ministry of Power, Government of India. Schools are requested to send the list of students participating in the painting competition (Category wise) to their State Nodal Officers. It is also mentioned that those schools who would record 100% participation at the School level Painting Competition, their names will be included in the Painting Competition booklet prepared by BEE.

State level Competition:

The committee of experts will select up to 50 best paintings each for **Category 'A' & 'B'** out of the total numbers of the paintings sent by the respective School Principal of the State/UT and selected students will be invited at a designated place for State level on-the -spot painting competition of 2-hour duration on **6th November 2015**. The selected students will be paid Rs. 1000/- each in cash by the Nodal Officer on the day of their participation at State level painting competition. Their travel expenses will also be reimbursed as prescribed in the scheme.

The Committee of Experts/Jury of the two categories of that particular State/UT will select 13 best paintings for respective Categories separately with preference to students from Govt. Schools of rural areas on the day of competition itself for the following prizes:

The first, second and third prize winners of **Category 'A'** of the each State/UT level painting competition along with their guardian will be invited to Delhi to participate in the National Level Painting competition of 2 hours duration on **12th December, 2015** and results will be announced on **14th December, 2015**.

Only paintings of 1st, 2nd and 3rd prize winners of State Level Painting Competition of the **Category 'B'** from each State/UT will be evaluated at Delhi by a Committee of Experts/Jury nominated for their selection for National level prizes.

Boarding & Lodging, to & fro sleeper class / AC Chair Car / 3rd AC rail-fare or State Roadways bus fare by the shortest route for 108 participant and two guardians per participant of **Category 'A'** and 12 winners of **Category 'B'** along with one guardian per participant will be reimbursed. In addition, each participating student will be paid a sum of Rs.1000/- as incidentals and given a participation certificate.

The Selection Committee/Jury will select 23 best paintings/posters for **Category 'A'** for the following prizes:



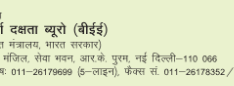
