GOLDEN JUBILEE COMMEMORATION OF THE INDO-PAK WAR 1965

The Indo-Pakistani War of 1965 saw the Indian and Pakistani Air Forces engaged in large-scale aerial combat against each other for the first time since the partition of India, in 1947. The war took place during the course of September 1965, on the Western front, and saw both air forces conduct defensive and offensive operations over their airspace. Fifty years after the two countries fought the war, the countless acts of courage, sacrifice and heroism of the Indian Armed Forces and the Central Police Organisations are, today, testified by their medals and citations. Their accounts bring recollections, and serve as the basis to rebuild a collage of experiences to be shared with our students
