Subject: Discontinuation of Academic and Vocational Subjects at Secondary and Senior Secondary Level from session 2018-19

This is in continuation of Circular Acad-10/2017 dated 09.03.2017. It is once again brought in to the notice of all the schools affiliated to CBSE that the subjects enlisted below are discontinued from the scheme of studies of CBSE with effect from the session 2018-19. Accordingly, schools are advised not to offer these subjects at the in classes IX and XI from the forthcoming session of 2018-19. However, the students pursuing these subjects currently in class IX and XI shall continue with them in Class X and XII in the session 2018-19.


