Since 1949, 7th December is observed as the Armed Forces Flag Day throughout India to honour our martyrs and the men and women in uniform who valiantly fight on our borders to safeguard the country's honour. It is an important occasion when the entire Nation comes together to express their gratitude to the Indian Armed Forces and also an occasion to remind us of our obligation to look after our veterans, disabled soldiers, widows and dependents of those who have sacrificed their lives for the

The Armed Forces Flag Day Fund (AFFDF) has been constituted by the Government of India for the welfare and rehabilitation of Ex-servicemen (ESM), war widows and their dependents. There are about more than 30 lakh ESM including around 6.5 lakh war widows in the country. Around 60,000 ESM are added to this list, every year. Financial assistance is provided for their basic sustenance needs such as penury grant, children's education grant, funeral grant, medical grant and orphan/disabled children grant out of AFFDF (list of welfare scheme is attached). The Fund is operated through Kendriya Sainik Board (KSB) Secretariat, which is an attached office under the administrative control of the Department of Ex-Servicemen Welfare, Ministry of Defence.

May I request you to convey this message to All Schools and educational institutions under the ambit of CBSE to celebrate 7 Dec as "Armed Forces Flag Day": The celebrations may include cultural events, motivational runs, swatchata drive and awareness capsules to inculcate a feeling of patriotism, pride and empathy for their soldiers/ESM/widows. The faculty and students may also be motivated to donate generously for the welfare of Indian Armed Forces Veterans and their families.) Contributions should be received in the name of Armed Forces Flag Day Fund, New Delhi.
