Sub: PISA Portal-Student and Teacher Data input by UT Chandigarh, KVS and NVS.

In order to boost recognition and acceptability of Indian students and prepare them for the global economy in the 21st century, Government of India has approved an agreement between India and the Organization for Economic Cooperation and Development (OECD) for participating in Programme for International Students Assessment (PISA)- 2021 and it has also been decided that in the 1st Phase, all the students of Kendriya Vidyalayas, Navodaya Vidyalayas and UT of Chandigarh born between 1st Feb'2004 and 31st January 2006 (inclusive of both dates) will be covered for the Field Trial in 2020 and Main Survey in 2021.

- 2. Students and teachers need to be sensitized about typology of questions and, therefore, Government needs the details of all the students (born between above dates) and teachers. To capture these details, Government has launched a website on PISA which can be accessed through <a href="http://www.samagra.mhrd.gov.in">http://www.samagra.mhrd.gov.in</a>
- 3. In view of the above, all the schools situated in Chandigarh are directed to register on the portal <a href="http://www.samagra.mhrd.gov.in">http://www.samagra.mhrd.gov.in</a> by using 11-digit UDISE code of their school and upload the student's and teacher's data by **22nd April 2019** without fail.
- 4. The details of students and teachers can be uploaded through the school login. The user name and password for all the schools is the 11-digit UDISE code. The system will prompt to change the password, once it is logged for the first time. The details are given in the user instructions on the website.
- 5. To monitor the progress at the school level, separate usernames have been created which can be made available by sending mail to <a href="mailto:pisa.mhrd@gmail.com">pisa.mhrd@gmail.com</a>.
