Subject :150th Birth Anniversary Celebrations of Mahatma Gandhi

Mahatma Gandhi is the symbol of peace and truth. Gandhian thoughts, principles, values and ideals encourage our students to always be with the truth and have non – violent path towards their progress.

In order to mark the celebrations of **150th Birth Anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi**, two yearlong (from October 2018 till October 2020) activities are being carried out across the country.

The schools may also be a part of the celebrations by conducting different activities throughout the year, from 2nd October 2019 to 2nd October 2020. The lists of yearlong activities that can be organized at the school level are as follows:

S. No.	Time Line	Activity
1.	July – October, 2019	Students of classes I to V can be taught about Sadachar like truth, non – violence, seva etc. in their mother tongue and students of classes VI to XII can be taught about <i>'How Gandhi is</i> <i>relevant even in today's context'</i> by organizing debate, essay and painting competitions
2.	23-9-2019 to 1-10-2019	One week intensive activities on the life and values of Mahatma Gandhi as given in the second table may be organized in school
3.	2 nd October, 2019	Gandhi Jayanti homage on 2 nd October followed by cultural programme by students on life of Gandhiji
4.	November, 2019	Special cleanliness drive in and around the school may be organized
5.	December, 2019	Speech during morning assembly by students/ teachers/resource persons on different aspects of truthfulness and violence
6.	Jan – Feb, 2020	Quiz on life of Gandhiji
7.	July to October, 2020	Essay and Painting workshops
8.	2 nd October, 2020	Gandhi Jayanti homage on 2 nd October followed by cultural programme by students on life of Gandhiji

30-09-2019	Visits to museums and places associated with Gandhiji / screening of films
