- National level essay, debate and quiz competitions on Fundamental Duties and themes iii. related to Constitution may be organized across the country, the winners at State and National levels may be suitably rewarded.
- Reading of Preamble and Fundamental Duties. iv.

Organizing Mock Parliament. V.

- Public messages on Fundamental Duties for dissemination among students and staff vi. during the celebrations. Brochures, pamphlets and e-posters on Fundamental Duties may be prepared in Hindi, English and regional languages and distributed in Schools among
- Effective utilization of Government/ Organization websites and MyGov platform to vii. encourage citizen centric activities on the prescribed theme. Students may be encouraged to participate in online quiz/ Olympiad competitions being organized by MyGov.
