Subject:- Nominations of teachers for the Japanese Government (MEXT) Scholarship for school teachers wishing to conduct research on School Education at designated Japanese Universities as Teachers Training Students for the academic year – 2022.

1. Ministry of Education, Government of India has sought nominations for nine Teachers Under Japanese Government (MEXT) Scholarship- 2022 from independent schools/Government schools other than KVS and NVS affiliated to CBSE.
2. Principals can forward the nomination of their teachers having at least ten years' experience in primary/secondary education along with a research proposal prepared by the teacher. Teacher must also possess a valid passport. Rest of the requirement will be as per the qualifications/eligibility criteria in mentioned in the Annexure – A. The candidates will be selected by an evaluation process bases on their research proposal, interview and written test in Delhi.
