Background:

Mizo Language is written in the simple Roman script, with a phonetic form of spelling based on the well-known Hunterian system. It belongs to the Tibeto- Burman family of languages. Spoken by more than one million people mainly in Mizoram state in India, and also in Chin state in Burma, and in the Chittagong Hill tracks in Bangladesh and in neighbouring states in India.

In Mizoram though the area is large and there are a number of kindred tribes who could all be roughly described as Mizos, there was practically no difference in the language spoken by the people.

As in Chinese and many other languages, so in Mizo, the tone of a word determines the meaning. There are three main tones- the upward, the downward and the middle level.

Writing of Mizo was introduced to the Mizo by the two Christian pioneer missionaries J.H Lorrain and F.W Savidge in the late 18th century. Mizo language is recognized by the State Government as official language within the state.

Objectives:

- 1. To develop the ability and knowledge required in order to engage in independent reflection and enquiry
- 2. For the prevention and promotion of Mizo language and literature
- 3. To build confidence and proficiency in oral and written communication.
- 4. To use appropriate Mizo to communicate in various social settings.
- 5. To develop curiousity and creativity through extensive reading.
- 6. To facilitate self learning to enable them to become independent learners.
