XII PAINTING COMPETITION ON ENERGY CONSERVATION

NOTIFICATION

The **Central Board of Secondary Education** joins hands with the **Ministry of Power and Bureau of Energy Efficiency** in conducting the National Level Painting Competition to inculcate the habit of energy conservation among students. The competition aims to sensitize them towards issues of energy conservation.

In 2015, more than one lakh students participated. The winners of the competition were felicitated by the Hon'ble Union Minister of State for Power, Coal and New & Renewable Energy (Independent Charge), Shri Piyush Goyal, at a ceremony held in Vigyan Bhawan, New Delhi.

Eligibility: Students of 4th, 5th & 6th standard under **Category 'A'** and for 7th, 8th & 9th standard under **Category 'B'**, are eligible to participate.

The competition is held in three stages, namely, **School, State and National Levels.**

School Level

1. Schools are requested to organize a Painting Competition of 2 hours duration in your school for students of 4th, 5th & 6th students under **Category 'A'** and for 7th, 8th & 9th students under **Category 'B'** on any working day. Children can select any one of the following topics for the Painting Competition:

2. After the completion of painting competition, School Principal may select two best paintings along with information on the total no. of participants, percentage participation of students in both **Categories i.e 'A' & 'B'** (as applicable) and send them to the address of the Nodal Officer of their respective State/UT **by 30th September, 2016.** The back page of the paintings should carry the following information:

3. All participating students will be issued a **Certificate of Participation** by the Bureau of Energy Efficiency, Ministry of Power, Govt. of India. The list of state wise Nodal officials and scheme is available at www.beeindia.gov.in

Note: It is informed that all the participating students of School level painting competition will get a 'Certificate of participation' and 1st & 2nd selected will get 'Certificate of Merit' which will be signed by the respective school Principals and Director General, Bureau of Energy Efficiency, Ministry of Power, Government of India. Schools are requested to send the list of students participating in the painting competition (Category wise) to their State Nodal Officers. It is also mentioned that names of those schools which would record 100% participation at the school level Painting Competition; their names will be included in the Painting Competition booklet prepared by BEE.

State level

1. The committee of experts will select the top 50 paintings each for **Category 'A' & 'B'** out of the total number of the paintings sent by the respective School Principal of the State/UT and the selected students will be invited to a designated place for State level On-the -Spot Painting Competition which will be of 2-hour duration on **9th November 2016**. The selected students will be paid Rs. 2000/- each in cash by the Nodal Officer on the day of their participation at the State level painting competition. Their travel expenses will also be reimbursed as prescribed in the scheme.

2. The Committee of Experts/Jury of the two categories of that particular State/UT will select the top 13 paintings for the respective Categories separately with preference to students from Govt. Schools of rural areas on the day of competition itself for the following prizes:

National level

1. The first, second and third prize winners of **Category 'A'** of the each State/UT level painting competition along with their guardian will be invited to Delhi to participate in the National Level Painting competition of 2 hours duration on **12th December, 2016** and the results will be announced on **14th December, 2016**.

2. Only paintings of 1st, 2nd and 3rd prize winners of the State Level Painting Competition of the **Category 'B'** from each State/UT will be evaluated at Delhi by a Committee of Experts/Jury nominated for their selection for the National level prizes.

3. Boarding and Lodging, to and fro sleeper class / AC / Chair Car / 3rd AC rail-fare or State Roadways bus fare by the shortest route for 108 participant and two guardians per participant of **Category 'A'** and 12 winners of **Category 'B'** along with one guardian per participant will be reimbursed. In addition, each participating student will be paid a sum of Rs.2000/- for incidental expenses and a participation certificate.

4. The Selection Committee/Jury will select the 23 top paintings/posters for **Category 'A'** for the following prizes:

5. The selection Committee/Jury will also select prize winning paintings for **Category 'B'** from the 1st, 2nd & 3rd winners of State Level Painting Competition for the following Prizes:

Prizes and Certificates for Schools in India

- Attractive cash prizes worth Rs. 95,000/- per State/UT per Category (Rs. 34.20 lakhs for 36 States/UTs per Category or Rs. 68.40 lakhs for both categories) will be distributed to the State level winners on day of the competition on 9th November, 2016.
- For winners of the National Competition, cash prizes worth Rs.10.35 lakhs for both the categories are proposed to be awarded on 14th December, 2016, which is also celebrated as **National Energy Conservation Day**, in the presence of eminent dignitaries holding high positions in the Government. **Therefore, in total, Rs. 78.75 lakhs worth of prizes will be distributed in the Painting Competition Scheme.**
- All the participating students whose lists have been forwarded to State/UT Nodal officer, will be issued a **Certificate of Participation** by the Bureau of Energy Efficiency, Ministry of Power, Government of India.

Prizes and Certificates for Schools Located Abroad

1. The paintings received from the schools located outside India and having affiliation with Indian School Education Boards under **Category 'A'**, will also be adjudged for the following by the Committee of Experts/Jury comprising of renowned personalities from field of Art etc., Ministry of Power and Bureau of Energy Efficiency;

- 1st Prize** Amount in Indian Rs equivalent to US\$ 500/-
- 2nd Prize** Amount in Indian Rs equivalent to US\$ 300/-
- 3rd Prize** Amount in Indian Rs equivalent to US\$ 200/-

2. The **Certificate of Appreciation** will also be sent under the signature of Director General, Bureau of Energy Efficiency to the students whose paintings have been forwarded to BEE. These schools are requested to send two best paintings under each Category directly, along with the details as mentioned above, to: **the Bureau of Energy Efficiency (BEE), Sewa Bhawan, R.K.Puram, Sector-1, New Delhi-110066 (INDIA) office address. The competition for schools located abroad will be limited up to School level competition.**

3. The active participation of your school in this national activity will be helpful in sensitizing and educating school children, parents as well as teachers regarding the importance of energy conservation that would go a long way in carrying forward the energy conservation movement in the country. **Please see annexure 01 and 02 for further details.**

School Level Painting Competition

- School Principals are requested to organize painting competition of the 2 hours duration for 4th, 5th & 6th standard students under Category 'A' and for 7th, 8th & 9th standard students under Category 'B'. Students can use any size of paper but preferably A4 size and painting material such as pencil, colour pencils, crayons & water colours. Students can select any one of the above mentioned themes marked for their category for painting. (Schools located in National Capital Region will have the choice to participate in the Delhi State Level Painting competition)
- School principals will select 2 best paintings from each Category 'A' & 'B' and send them along with the information on total number of students participated in each category at School Level Painting Competition to the Nodal Officer of the State/UT whose address is given below so as to reach him by 30th September, 2016 positively.
- The back of the painting should carry the following information:
Name of the Student, Father's/Mother's Name, Tel/Mobile No. of Parents, Standard, Roll No, Category, School Name & Postal Address, Govt. School in Rural area (Write Yes or No) School Tel No., Sign of School Principal, State/UT
- All participants will be issued certificate of participation.

State Level Painting Competition

- 50 (plus 5 reserves) best paintings each for Categories 'A' & 'B' will be selected by a Committee of Experts/Jury.
- Selected students from categories 'A' & 'B' will be called at designated place in State/UT for two hours on the spot Painting Competition to be held on 9th November, 2016.
- Each participating student from Categories 'A' & 'B' will be paid ₹ 2000/- in cash and a participation certificate.
- To & fro Sleeper class / AC Chair Car / 3rd AC rail-fare or State Roadways bus fare for the participating student and two guardians for Category 'A' but only one guardian for Category 'B' will also be reimbursed on the day of the competition.
- Prizes shall be given away on the same day.
- Competition for Category 'B' will terminate at State level & first 03 Painting of winners at State Level will be evaluated for their selection for National Level prizes.

National Level Painting Competition

- 1st, 2nd and 3rd prize winners of State Level Painting Competition of the Category 'A' from each State/UT will be invited to Delhi to participate in "National Level Painting Competition" to be held on 12th December, 2016.
- Only paintings of 1st, 2nd and 3rd prize winners of State Level Painting Competition of the Category 'B' from each State/UT will be evaluated at Delhi by a Committee of Experts/Jury nominated for their selection for National Level prizes.
- Boarding & Lodging, to & fro sleeper class / AC Chair Car / 3rd AC rail-fare or State Roadways bus fare by the shortest route for 108 participants and two guardians of Category 'A' and 12 winners of Category 'B' along with one guardian will be reimbursed. In addition, each participating student will be paid a sum of ₹ 2000/- as incidentals and given a participation certificate.
- National Level winners of both Categories 'A' & 'B' will be awarded cash prizes by the Chief Guest on the "National Energy Conservation Day Function" to be held in Delhi on 14th December, 2016.

Note

- The 1st, 2nd & 3rd prizes winners at State/UT level during the last two years (2014 & 2015) of Category 'A' and 'B' are not eligible to participate in this year Competition but the Consolation prize winners at State Level of both Categories are eligible to participate but they would be considered for prizes only if they secure 1st/2nd/3rd position.
- Use of Collage/Patchwork is not permitted in the paintings at all levels of competition.
- Names of the schools who have recorded 100% participation in the Categories 'A' & 'B' (as applicable) will be published in the Painting Competition booklet prepared by BEE.
- Two paintings selected at School Level, sketched paintings at State/UT Level and National Level would be the sole property of BEE, which will have the right to use it for any purpose it considers appropriate.
- Eight awards would also be presented based on performance achieved for Category 'A' in the following sections for the State/UT Education Department and Nodal Officers who have ensured highest School & Student participation and percentage improvement over the best of previous two years (2014 & 2015).
 - Best State Education Department and Nodal Officer (Other than North – Eastern States)
 - Best State Education Department and Nodal Officer (North – Eastern States)
 - Best Union Territory Education Department and Nodal Officer
 - Best State/Union Territory Education Department and Nodal Officer recording Highest % Student Participation over previous year.
- The decision of the Jury/Expert Committee at all levels of the painting competition will be final.

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
