Orientation Session on 'Young Warrior NXT Program, Life Skills Training Initiative' in association with UNICEF, YuWaah and Udhyam Learning Foundation

As you are aware that CBSE in collaboration with UNICEF, YuWaah and Udhyam Learning Foundation launched the #YoungWarriorNXT, a year-long initiative, vide <u>CBSE Notification no.</u> 99/2021 dated 26<sup>th</sup> October 2021, with an aim is to empower 10 million young people, in the age group of 14-24 years, with essential life and employability skills such as communication, problem solving, self awareness etc. and enable them to achieve success in both professional and personal life.

As an extension of the #YoungWarriorNXT movement, around 100 schools will be selected to run an in-class 'Life Skills Training Initiative' of class 9 and 11 students between January-February 2022, for 4 weeks. The performance of the selected schools & teachers will be recognized at an appropriate event. The students will also receive participation certificates by UNICEF and CBSE.

To kickstart this initiative, CBSE, in collaboration with UNICEF, YuWaah and Udhyam Learning Foundation, is organizing an online orientation session (refer Annexure-I) for Principals / Vice Principals / Senior Teachers of the schools affiliated to the Board as per the schedule given below. 

# Orientation for Principals of CBSE affiliated schools about the #YoungWarriorsNXT movement, Life Skills Training Initiative

### **❖** Key features of the Life Skills Training Initiative in CBSE schools

- 1. Blended learning: Students learn the concepts through an engaging WhatsApp chatbot and then reflect on their learnings in the classrooms, through facilitation support by teachers. This allows students to learn independently, share learnings with peers & assimilate learning.
- **2. Reflective learning**: The activities on the chatbot require students to reflect on their personal experiences. 20 in total, these activities cover 4 essential life and employability skills.
- **3.** Implementation Model of the Initiative: This programme comprises of 3 steps:
  - a. Training of Master Trainers by Udhyam Learning Foundation
  - b. Training of Teachers by Master Trainers
  - c. Training of Students by Teachers
- **4. Certificates for participation:** Schools, Master Trainers, teachers and students will be recognized for their participation in this initiative by CBSE and UNICEF.
- **5. Privacy:** Students' usage data will be anonymized and none of students' identifiable information will be collected.
