- * Key features of the Online Entrepreneurship Programme (OEP) -
- 1. **Blended learning-** Students learn the concepts through online sessions and then pursue real life business projects based on them to build a deeper understanding. This allows students to learn independently in addition to facilitator support.
- 2. **Real life learning-** Students not only understand business and entrepreneurship theoretically, but actually craft a business idea of their interest, engage with real customers, do surveys etc. to put the concepts in practice.
- 3. **Reflective learning-** Students learn from reflecting on their personal experience of starting their business. Managing a business could be an intensely engaging experience which builds a solid ground for learners to derive learnings from it and enhance their self-awareness.
- ❖ Implementation Model of the Programme- This programme comprises of 3 steps-
 - 1. Training of master trainers by ULF
 - 2. Training of teachers by Master Trainers
 - 3. Training of students by Teachers
- **❖** Highlights of the Master trainers training programme are-
 - > Objectives of the programme-
 - Understanding the concept of Enterpreunership and OEP programme design.
 - Practicing facilitation techniques
 - ➤ **Time duration** 10 Hours formal training that includes 1 hour of Online Induction and 9 hours of online training (3 hours per day for 3 days)
 - > The trained facilitators/Master Trainers will train teachers

The teachers trained will further impart training to their students.
