Call for Submissions: Sapno Ki Udaan, June 2025 Issue

Theme: Archaeology and Historical Sites of India: Different Dimensions

The **June 2025** issue of *Sapno Ki Udaan* aims to celebrate and critically explore India's rich archaeological legacy, ancient architecture, and the many stories told through ruins, artifacts, and preserved heritage sites.

We welcome creative works that explore the cultural, artistic, scientific and human aspects of India's historical and archaeological wonders on the sub-themes listed below (but not limited to):

Sub-Themes

- Ancient Civilizations of the Subcontinent (Harappan, Mauryan, Gupta, etc.)
- Lost Cities and Forgotten Settlements
- Underwater Archaeology in India
- Excavation Experiences: Student/Amateur Archaeologists
- Sacred Spaces and Ritual Landscapes
- Temples, Forts, and Palaces: Stories in Stone
- Conservation and Preservation of Heritage
- Role of ASI (Archaeological Survey of India)
- Tribal History and Rock Art
- Artefacts and Their Stories (coins, pottery, tools, inscriptions)
- Technological Advances in Archaeology (e.g., Ground Penetrating Radar, 3D Mapping)
- Myths, Legends, and Folklore Around Monuments
- Architectural Marvels and Design Evolution
- Heritage Walks and Cultural Tourism
- Monuments in Conflict Zones or Under Threat
- Colonial Archaeology and its Impact
- Museum Stories: Behind the Display
- Gender and Archaeology: Women in History and Fieldwork
- School Visits to Historical Sites: Reflections
- Monuments as Sites of Memory and Identity

General Guidelines

Submissions should offer fresh insights, personal experiences, or creative interpretations of India's historical and archaeological heritage. Contributions can blend storytelling with art with history, or imagination with evidence.

Categories and Word Limits

1. **Poems (12–32 lines)**

Explore the silence and the grandeur of ancient architecture, or the whispers of a lost civilization through verse.

2. Stories (600–1200 words)

Tell a fictional or real story centered on a historical site, probably a hidden artifact, a time-travel experience, or a day in the life of an ancient city.

3. Articles (700–1500 words)

Share informative content on archaeology, historical sites, excavation findings, or conservation efforts in India.

4. Dialogues or Plays (400–700 words)

Create conversations between a historian and a monument, between past and present, or between characters exploring a heritage site.

5. Essays (500–800 words)

Present thoughtful reflections on the importance of preserving our history, the role of monuments in identity, or what ruins teach us.

6. Illustrations and Posters (high-resolution artwork of at least 300 dpi)

Draw monuments, excavation scenes, archaeological tools, or imagined reconstructions of ancient cities.

7. **Profiles (400–800 words)**

Write about archaeologists, historians, conservationists etc. who bring the past to life.

8. Travelogues (800–1200 words)

Narrate your visit to a historical site—your observations, the ambiance, the legends, and what you learned.

9. **State Snapshots - Infographics or Creative Write-ups (up to 500 words)** Highlight a state's archaeological gems—major monuments, heritage trails, architectural styles, or tribal histories.

10. Photography (High-resolution JPEG/PNG, min 300 dpi)

Submit photographs of historical sites, intricate carvings, excavation scenes, or architectural highlights with a 50 - 100-word caption. (Avoid pictures with personal presence)

11. State Trivia / Quizzes (20–30 questions)

Design fun and informative quizzes on Indian archaeology, monuments, and history by state or period.

12. **Reflections (500–1000 words)**

Share how exploring a historical site impacted you—emotionally, intellectually, or culturally. What did you discover about yourself or your heritage?

13. Career Guidance

Explore careers in archaeology, heritage conservation, museum curation, or architectural history. Include interviews or insights from professionals, if possible.

Submission Guidelines

- All submissions must be original and unpublished.
- **Artwork** must be original or used with proper permissions.
- **Plagiarism and machine-generated content** will result in disqualification.
- Adhere to the word limits as per each category mentioned.

- o Hindi: Unicode, 14pt, 1.5-line spacing
- Submit in DOC/DOCX or PDF format
- O Photographs/drawings/pictures must be High-resolution, JPEG/PNG, min 300 dpi
